

CONTEST: “ENTER FOR YOUR CHANCE TO WIN A FAMILY GETAWAY!”

Rules

1. The “CAPRINA GETAWAY !” contest is held Produits de Soins pour la Peau au Lait de Chèvre Canus, Inc. / Canus Goat's Milk Skin Care Products, Inc. (the “**Contest Organizer**” or “**Canus**”) The contest will take place on the web site of capria.com from April 9th, 2018, at 9:00 a.m., to August 31st, 2018, at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time (the “**Contest Period**”).

2. **Eligibility.** This contest is open to residents of Canada except those residing in the Northwest Territories, Yukon and Nunavut, who have reached the age of majority in their province of residence at the time of entry. Employees, agents and representatives of the Contest Organizer or any company, corporation, trust or other legal entity controlled by or affiliated with the Contest Organizer, their advertising and promotion agencies, suppliers of materials or services related to the contest, as well as members of their immediate families (brothers, sisters, children, mother, father), their legal or common-law spouse and any individuals with whom these employees, representatives and agents are domiciled, are not eligible to participate in the contest.

3. To enter the contest, you must:

a) Complete the participation form generated the web site www.caprina.com during the Contest Period. To do this, you must complete the following fields:

3. Your email address
4. Your address
5. Your phone number
6. Your favorite destination, namely 1) the mountain, 2) the forest, or 3) the lake.

b) Then check the following three mandatory boxes:

a) I consent to receive electronic communications from Canus, including offers, coupons, contests, press releases, surveys and VIP information. I understand that I can unsubscribe at any time and that unsubscribing will not affect my chances of winning. To unsubscribe, I must click on the “Unsubscribe” link at the bottom of the email sent by Canus. c) Finally, submit your entry by clicking “Send.” You will then be entered in the contest.

4. Participation limits. Entrants must respect the limit of one (1) entry per person, failure to do so will lead to disqualification.

5. Prize. The winner will receive a weekend for 4 people in a nature location. The prize includes: 4 meals per person, 2 nights and at least (1) recreational and / or sports activity. The prize includes only what is specifically described, nothing further will be allocated. 8. Prize claim. To be declared a winner, the selected entrant must:

8.1 Be reached by email or private message within two (2) days of the draw and respond to the message within two (2) days of receiving it in order to provide their contact information (name, full mailing address, email address and telephone number).

8.2 Complete and sign the declaration and release form (the "Declaration") confirming compliance with these Rules and correctly answer the skill-testing mathematical question on the Declaration. The selected entrant will receive the Declaration from the Contest Organizer via email or private message and must return it in the prescribed manner so that the Contest Organizer receives the completed Declaration within five (5) business days of its receipt by the selected entrant.

8.3 On request and in a timely fashion, produce one piece of photo identification.

9. Failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned in these Rules or to accept the Prize will result in the selected entrant being disqualified. In such a case, the Contest Organizer may, at its sole discretion, cancel the Prize or proceed with a new draw in accordance with these Rules until a selected entrant is declared a winner.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

In the event of such an attempt, the Contest Organizer reserves the right to disqualify the entrant and seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law.

15. Prize substitution. 19. Contest modification. The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend, in whole or in part, this contest should human intervention or an event take place that could interfere or affect the proper administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the contest as provided by these Rules, subject to the approval of the Régie des alcools des courses et des jeux du Québec, if required.

20. Termination of participation in the contest.
